

Camp Wilabosca Emergency Procedure

In case of Emergency (i.e. fire, medical) the person in charge or their assistant will warn all campers of the emergency with a series of three whistle blasts. The three blast warning will be repeated as many times as necessary to alert all campers. A runner must be sent to alert groups at the tent sites as they may not hear the whistle.

Upon hearing the three blast warning, all campers will go to the flag pole and await instructions from the person(s) in charge. When the campers have assembled, the person in charge will conduct a head count to determine if all campers are present. Any absent campers will be reported to the emergency personnel when they arrive if appropriate. If necessary, the person in charge will move the campers to the upper parking lot, making sure that they are well clear of the roadway.

The person in charge will report the emergency via a 911 phone call if appropriate.

If emergency vehicles have been summoned, the person in charge will send someone to North Shore Rd. to ensure that the emergency vehicles do not miss the turn onto the camp road. The person in charge will ensure that there are no vehicles blocking the roadway and that the emergency vehicles will be able to gain access to the property.
